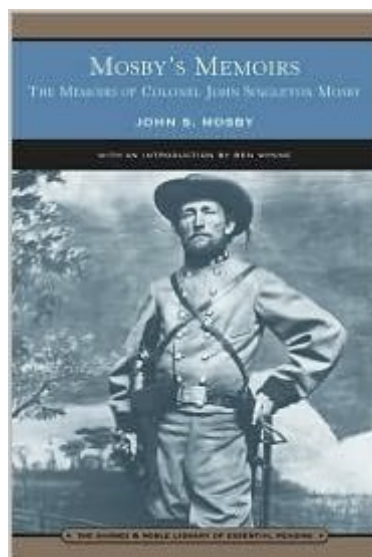

Mosby was a lawyer who enlisted as a private and declined an early officer commission in order to learn the business from the ground up, and served under JEB Stuart's Virginia Cavalry. The book is filled with letters, many to his wife as well as many correspondences between key officers and politicians of both North & South. It is clear that his experience in the war garnered strong opinions that led him to post-war research in order to set the record straight and call some dishonest people to account. This process culminates in a book that is essential reading for anyone seriously interested in Civil War history, particularly from a southern perspective. What unfolds is the remarkable perspective of a very impressive individual.
